WATERLOO COUNTRY CLUB, INC GOLF COURSE GUIDELINES AND POLICY HIGHLIGHTS 2024*

PLAYERS ON GOLF COURSE

Players, each in sole possession of his or her own golf clubs and golf bag will be permitted on the course.

BAG TAGS AND ANNUAL GOLF PASSES

All members of the Waterloo Country Club shall openly display the required golf bag tag properly on their golf bag. Members with annual cart passes shall display that tag prominently on their golf bag.

DRESS CODE

Members and their guests are expected to wear appropriate golf attire. Men and boys are required to wear collared golf shirt with sleeves or a mock turtle neck with sleeves. Women and girls are required to wear collared or collarless golf shirts; golf dresses, skorts and shorts must be of an appropriate length. Appropriate golf attire excludes bike & running shorts, cutoffs, tank tops, t-shirts and swim suits. Only soft golf spikes shall be used.

UNMARRIED SONS AND DAUGHTERS / GUESTS

No one individual may be a guest of the golf course more than five [5] times per calendar year and must be accompanied by a member; all members are responsible to insure payment of golf fees by their guests.

MINIMUM AGE OF PLAYERS

No player under the age of 12 years will be permitted on the golf course without parental, adult (defined as anyone over the age of 16), or club sponsored supervision. On Sundays, no one under the age of 12, with or without supervision, is allowed on the course prior to 1:00 pm.

BEGINNING PLAY

All golfers MUST start on the #1 tee unless they receive permission from the caddy shack.

UNIT OF PLAY

The prescribed unit of play is the foursome; Threesomes, twosomes, and onesomes have no rights on the golf course. Fivesomes are permitted during the week April 1 – Oct 15 (except for holidays and league play) and all days from October 16 to March 31).

SLOW PLAY

Slow play WILL NOT BE TOLERATED! Except for tournament rounds, ALL 18 hole rounds should be played in 4 hours or less and all 9 hole rounds in 2 hours or less.

PLAY ON PAR 3 HOLES

When playing the par 3 holes numbered 2 and 9, each group shall afford the following group the opportunity to play their stroke from the teeing ground once each player in the front group has reached the green.

MOTOTRIZED GOLF CARTS

Motorized golf carts shall be operated only by individuals possessing a valid driver's license and should remain on the cart paths when Cart Path Only sign is posted and overall whenever possible.

BEVERAGES

All beverages consumed on the course follow the same rules governing the club grounds which require purchasing beverages from the clubhouse or caddy shack, unless an exception has been granted.
